



# Firebox® V60L Addendum

Thank you for purchasing the WatchGuard Firebox V60L. The Firebox V60L provides many of the same hardware and software features as the rest of the Vclass family. When you are reading your WatchGuard documentation, it is useful to think of the Firebox V60L as the Firebox V60 with a slightly different set of features. This document describes the differences between the Firebox V60L and the Firebox V60.

## 1 V60L and V60 Capabilities

The following table shows the differences in capabilities between the WatchGuard Firebox V60L and the WatchGuard Firebox V60.

### Other Tunnel Limitations

The V60L and the V60 include 20 free MUVPN (RAS User) licenses by default. The total MUVPN (RAS User) limit on the V60L is 100.

### V60L Hardware Features

The V60L hardware has the same hardware features and ports as the V60. For a description of the hardware features, see your *Firebox V10, V60, V80, V100 Hardware Guide*.

#### **Using the HA Ports**

The High Availability (HA) feature is not enabled on the V60L. The HA ports on the V60L do not provide HA/Active Standby (HA/AS) functionality in the default configuration. However, you can use the HA ports as direct console connections for administration of the V60L.

High Availability Active/Standby is available as an optional upgrade.

### V60L Software Features

The V60L can be configured using Vcontroller, CPM, or the Command Line Interface.
